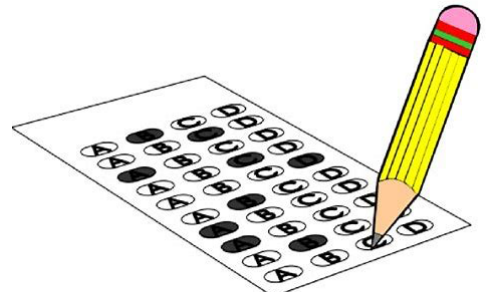

ARE YOU GOING TO THE OFFICE?

1. Pick up the phone to be buzzed in! **No need to print a badge.**

ARE YOU GOING INTO THE SCHOOL?

1. Head over to our kiosk
2. Insert your **Valid Government Issued Photo ID** into our scanner and follow the instructions on the screen to print your badge.
3. Present your **Valid Government Issued Photo ID** to our office staff to be fully checked in.
4. Head into the school!
5. Make sure to check out and return your Visitor's Badge to the front office staff on your way out of the school!
